

New development for first-time homebuyers

The Daniels Corporation, which has been behind numerous developments across Greater Toronto, will unveil its eighth FirstHome Community project this weekend called FirstHome Brampton.

Located off Bramalea Road, just north of Sandalwood Parkway, this community features 150 fully built one- and two-storey condominium townhomes priced from \$159,900.
